309-372-04 1 A bill to be entitled 2 An act relating to trust funds; re-creating the Florida Coastal Protection Trust Fund within 3 4 the Department of Environmental Protection 5 without modification; carrying forward current balances and continuing current sources and 6 7 uses thereof; providing an effective date. 8 9 WHEREAS, the Legislature wishes to extend the life of the Florida Coastal Protection Trust Fund within the 10 Department of Environmental Protection, which is otherwise 11 12 scheduled to be terminated pursuant to constitutional mandate, 13 and WHEREAS, the Legislature has reviewed the trust fund 14 before its scheduled termination date and has found that it 15 16 continues to meet an important public purpose, and 17 WHEREAS, the Legislature has found that existing public policy concerning the trust fund sets adequate parameters for 18 19 its use, NOW, THEREFORE, 20 21 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 22 23 Section 1. (1) The Florida Coastal Protection Trust Fund within the Department of Environmental Protection, FLAIR 24 25 number 37-2-099, which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 26 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 27 2004, is re-created. 2.8 (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried 29 forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund 30 are continued. 31
