21	United States Armed Forces Reserves or the Florida National
22	Guard while those employees are on federal active duty. Grants
23	shall be awarded for monthly wages paid to employees who are
24	residents of this state for the actual period of federal active
25	duty. Grants may not be provided for federal active duty served
26	prior to January 1, 2004. The monthly grant per employee may not
27	exceed one-half of the monthly wages paid by the employer to the
28	employee at the level paid prior to the date the employee was
29	called to federal active duty, minus the amount of the
