(1) The Nonmandatory Land Reclamation Trust Fund within the Department of Environmental Protection, 24 25 FLAIR number 37-2-506, which is to be terminated pursuant to 26 Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on 27 November 4, 2004, is re-created. 2.8 (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund 29 30 are continued. 31
