Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 1011.62, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1011.62 Funds for operation of schools.--If the annual allocation from the Florida Education Finance Program to each district for operation of schools is not determined in the annual appropriations act or the substantive bill implementing the annual appropriations act, it shall be determined as follows:

(2) DETERMINATION OF DISTRICT COST DIFFERENTIALS.--The Commissioner of Education shall annually compute for each district the current year's district cost differential.

- (a) Determination of district cost differential for
 districts with a 2003-2004 cost differential greater than
 1.0000.--The district cost differential shall be the greater of:
- 1. The district cost differential shall be calculated by adding each district's price level index as published in the Florida Price Level Index for the most recent 3 years and dividing the resulting sum by 3. The result for each district shall be multiplied by 0.008 and to the resulting product shall be added 0.200; or
 - 2. The lesser of:
 - a. 1.0000; or

- b. The cost differential that when used in the prior

 year's FEFP funding formula will result in the district's prior

 year funding per unweighted FTE being the same as the prior

 year's state average.
- (b) Determination of district cost differential for districts with a 2003-2004 cost differential of less than 1.0000.--
- 1. For fiscal years 2004-2005 through 2007-2008, the district cost differential shall be the greater of:
- a. The cost differential calculated by adding each district's price level index as published in the Florida Price Level Index for the most recent 3 years and dividing the resulting sum by 3. The result for each district shall be

multiplied by 0.008 and to the resulting product shall be added
0.200; or

b. The lesser of:

- (I) The district's 2003-2004 cost differential which shall be increased each year for 4 consecutive years by a factor that is calculated by subtracting from 1.000 the district's 2003-2004 cost differential and then dividing the result by 5; or
- (II) The cost differential that when used in the prior year's FEFP funding formula will result in the district's prior year funding per unweighted FTE being the same as the prior year's state average.
- 2. For fiscal years 2008-2009 and thereafter, the district cost differential shall be the greater of:
- a. The cost differential calculated by adding each district's price level index as published in the Florida Price

 Level Index for the most recent 3 years and dividing the resulting sum by 3. The result for each district shall be multiplied by 0.008 and to the resulting product shall be added 0.200; or
 - b. The lesser of:
 - (I) 1.0000; or
- (II) The cost differential that when used in the prior
 year's FEFP funding formula will result in the district's prior
 year funding per unweighted FTE being the same as the prior
 year's state average.
- (c) Calculation of prior year's state funding.--For the purpose of calculating prior year's state funding in this section, prior year's state funding shall include total state

and local formula and categorical funds for K-12 programs and
maximum potential discretionary local revenue and shall not
include funds for the Discretionary Lottery and School
Recognition Program the sum thus obtained shall be the cost
differential for that district for that year.
