This legislation re-creates the Contracts and Grants Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2004. The Contracts and Grants Trust Fund, FLAIR #42-2-133, is administered by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 2000, by Chapter 99-60, Laws of Florida.

II. Present Situation:

This trust fund is used to monitor and track federal funds administered by the department, which includes the poultry and egg grading program. According to LAS/PBS data, receipts to this fund for FY 2002-2003 were \$52.7 million.

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
