(1) The Incidental Trust Fund within the 23 Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, FLAIR number 24 42-2-381, which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 2004, is 25 26 <u>re-created.</u> (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried 27 28 forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund 29 are continued. 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect November 4, 31 2004.
