24	nondairy milk, and rice milk.
25	3. Fruit-based beverages that are composed of no less than
26	50 percent fruit juice.
27	4. Beverages with no added sugar content.
28	5. Noncaffeinated beverages.
29	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.
