- Section 1. Statute of limitations tolled in cases of sexual battery on a minor. -- The applicable statute of limitations for any civil or criminal action involving the offense of sexual battery on a minor shall be tolled during the period of the victim's minority and during any period in which it is therapeutically determined that:
- (1) The victim is unable to disclose information concerning the incident at issue outside of a clinical setting;
- (2) It is inadvisable for the victim to confront the perpetrator; or
- (3) It is medically inadvisable for the victim to disclose publicly the incident at issue.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.
