House Resolution

A resolution designating February 6, 2004, "Ronald Reagan Day" in Florida.

WHEREAS, President Ronald Wilson Reagan, elected in 1980 as the 40th President of the United States of America, served his nation and indeed the entire world with uncommon integrity, honor, and distinction, and

WHEREAS, following his first term in office, President Reagan was reelected by three-fifths of the electorate, winning in 49 of the 50 states, a record unsurpassed in the history of American presidential elections, and

WHEREAS, rising from a humble background, President Reagan was dedicated to an active social policy that resulted in lowered crime and drug use in the nation's neighborhoods, and his inauguration of a bold, bipartisan effort to restore accountability and common sense to government led to unprecedented economic expansion and opportunity for millions of Americans, and

WHEREAS, President Reagan's commitment to the country's armed forces contributed to the restoration of a sense of patriotism and pride in America and her values and those cherished by the free world and prepared the nation to meet 21st century challenges; and his vision of "peace through strength" led to the end of the Cold War and the ultimate demise of the Soviet Union, resulting in the reinstatement of basic human rights for millions of people, and
