House Resolution

A resolution endorsing the recommendation that the 2005 Super Bowl halftime show honor "America's Greatest Generation."

WHEREAS, on February 6, 2005, Super Bowl XXXIX will take place in Florida, almost 60 years following the end of a war fought and supported by men and women who have been aptly labeled "America's Greatest Generation," and

WHEREAS, this generation, which was predominantly born in the 1920's and grew up during the Great Depression, joined in a magnificent effort to help preserve world freedom from the greatest threat it had ever faced, after the war helped build the most prosperous nation in the world, and is now passing away at the rate of more than 1,500 individuals a day, and

WHEREAS, with a view toward "honoring the Greatest Generation before it is too late," it is suggested that a unique opportunity has arisen to recognize these American heroes through a timely and fitting thematic tribute during the 2005 Super Bowl halftime show, and it is further suggested that such a theme could be presented with a pregame flyover by WWII vintage aircraft, followed by a halftime patriotic musical salute, perhaps against a backdrop of a 1940's USO canteen with dancers in period dress and uniforms performing the "Jitterbug" to the toe-tapping, fast-moving music of the day, and

WHEREAS, the NFL, working in conjunction with the City of Jacksonville, could expand the theme to include week-long pregame festivities featuring 1940's automobiles and other memorabilia, parades, and special appearances by war heroes past

and present, and such outpouring of public appreciation would "win America's heart" and would be a memorable example of good manners and good taste worthy of the service and sacrifices of America's Greatest Generation, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Florida:

That the House of Representatives, recognizing Jacksonville will be in the world spotlight as host to Super Bowl XXXIX in February 2005, urges the officials and civic leaders of the city to strive to make this event an opportunity during which to offer to these aging heroes "America's Musical Salute to the Greatest Generation."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be presented to the NFL Super Bowl XXXIX Planning Committee as soon as possible, as a tangible token of the sentiments expressed herein.
