HR 9093 2004 House Resolution 1 2 A resolution commending the Florida Marlins, 2003 World 3 Series Champions. 4 5 WHEREAS, the Florida Marlins made their debut in the City б of Miami, Miami-Dade County, and the entire Miami area 11 years 7 aqo, and WHEREAS, the Marlins have subsequently recruited a 8 9 substantial number of outstanding players and coaches, achieving their first National League Championship against the Atlanta 10 Braves before going on to win their first World Series 11 12 Championship against the Cleveland Indians in 1997, and WHEREAS, the 2003 Florida Marlins won the National League 13 14 Division Series by defeating the San Francisco Giants on October 15 4, 2003, in three games out of four, then, having united South Florida in its support of the "Never-Say-Die Marlins," defeated 16 17 the Chicago Cubs in the seventh game by coming from behind to win the final three games of the series, and 18 WHEREAS, on October 25, 2003, the Marlins outscored the New 19 20 York Yankees 2-0 and became the first team to eliminate the 21 Yankees in Yankee Stadium in the playoffs since 1981, and WHEREAS, with that victory, the Florida Marlins won the 22 World Series to become the 2003 World Series Champions, NOW, 23 24 THEREFORE, 25 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of 26 Florida: 27 28
