5 WHEREAS, the Tallahassee campus of Florida State University 6 is the oldest continuous site of higher education in Florida and 7 holds the state's first chapter of Phi Beta Kappa, and

8 WHEREAS, in 1994, Florida State University joined an elite 9 group of the nation's top research universities when it was 10 designated by the Carnegie Foundation as a "Research I" 11 institution, and

12 WHEREAS, Florida State University, a national leader in 13 international education, with more than 40 years of experience 14 abroad, now has 38 such programs, including the most recent 15 summer program of study at Tianjin Foreign Studies University in 16 the People's Republic of China, and

WHEREAS, Florida State University offers graduate and undergraduate degrees in 565 fields within 17 independent colleges and schools, its comprehensive offerings preparing students for graduate school, professional degree programs, and successful careers, and

WHEREAS, recognized as the most "wired" campus in the state, Florida State University is setting the standard for distance learning and for utilizing technology in the classroom as well as campuswide, and

26 WHEREAS, because of its long-standing tradition of 27 promoting racial, ethnic, and cultural diversity on its campus, 28 along with an aggressive recruitment from among many diverse 29 groups, Florida State University's college experience proves to

41 That the House of Representatives designates April 20, 42 2004, as "F.S.U. Day" in Tallahassee in recognition of the 43 university's contributions as an outstanding institution of 44 higher education.
