I. Summary:

This bill re-creates the Grants and Donations Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2004. The Grants and Donations Trust Fund, FLAIR #68-2-339, is administered by the Agency for Health Care Administration. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 2000, by Chapter 2000-59, Laws of Florida.

This bill re-creates section 409.916, Florida Statutes.

II. Present Situation:

The trust fund is used to account for funds from pharmaceutical manufacturers (rebates, grants or other funds), funds for Medicaid research and development activities, Medicaid fraud and abuse recoupments, and intergovernmental transfers used for the state share of Disproportionate Share Hospital Programs and special Medicaid payments.
