 57 Section 1. Chapters 8705 (1921), 9464 (1923), 12847

59 24576 (1947), 24582 (1947), 27606 (1951), 27611 (1951), 30832  
 60 (1955), 59-1351, 59-1366, 63-1405, 67-1501, 71-495, 71-676, 71-  
 61 687, 73-489, and 80-505, Laws of Florida, are repealed.

62 Section 2. Such repeal shall not affect the prosecution of  
 63 any cause of action that accrued before the effective date of  
 64 this act and shall not affect the rules, regulations, policies,  
 65 actions, decisions, contracts, agreements, obligations, and  
 66 properties of the Hillsborough County School District or the  
 67 School Board of Hillsborough County existing prior to the  
 68 effective date of this act.

69 Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
