16 existing enterprise zone boundaries under specified

20 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

22 Section 1. Section 290.00703, Florida Statutes, is created

24 290.00703 Enterprise zone designation for the City of
 25 South Daytona.--The City of South Daytona may apply to the
 26 Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development for
 27 designation of one enterprise zone within the city. The
 28 application must be submitted by December 31, 2004, and must
 29 comply with the requirements of s. 290.0055. Notwithstanding the
 30 provisions of s. 290.0065 limiting the total number of
 31 enterprise zones designated and the number of enterprise zones
 32 within a population category, the Office of Tourism, Trade, and
 33 Economic Development may designate one enterprise zone under
 34 this section. The Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic
 35 Development shall establish the initial effective date of the
 36 enterprise zone designated under this section.

37 Section 2. Subsection (12) is added to section 290.0065,
 38 Florida Statutes, to read:

39 290.0065 State designation of enterprise zones.--

40 (12) Before November 30, 2004, any county as defined in s.
 41 125.011 may apply to the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic
 42 Development to change the boundaries of an existing enterprise
 43 zone for the purpose of replacing an area of not more than 75
 44 acres within the enterprise zone as of January 1, 2004, with an
 45 area of the same number of acres outside the enterprise zone as
 46 of January 1, 2004. The replacement area must be contiguous to
 47 the existing enterprise zone and must be a part of a
 48 revitalization area that has been targeted for assistance by the
 49 county. The replacement area also must be contiguous to a zoo
 50 and the county must have previously completed a master plan for
 51 development of the area. The Office of Tourism, Trade, and

52 Economic Development shall approve the amendment effective
53 January 1, 2005, if the enterprise zone remains consistent with
54 the criteria and conditions imposed by s. 290.0055 upon the
55 establishment of enterprise zones, including the requirement
56 that the area suffer from pervasive poverty, unemployment, and
57 general distress.

58 Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming law.
