A bill to be entitled

An act relating to coastal and waterfront preservation; providing the right to access, through public lands, certain coastal and waterfront areas during and immediately following a declared state of emergency; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 252.63, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

252.63 Coastal and waterfront preservation.--In order to meet the special needs of coastal and waterfront areas during and immediately following the time a state of emergency is declared by executive order or proclamation of the Governor under this chapter, access, through public lands, to any coastal or waterfront area in need of restoration, nourishment, or coastal construction shall be granted to all persons seeking to preserve or repair the coastal or waterfront area, as well as their vehicles and equipment, for 120 days immediately following the declaration of a state of emergency or for another limited time specified by the Governor.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
