An act relating to hurricane property insurance
deductibles; amending s. 627.701, F.S.; limiting
application of hurricane deductible amounts in a calendar
year; requiring the Florida Hurricane Catastrophe Fund to
develop a deductible loss reimbursement program for
insurance companies; providing an effective date.
Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
Section 1. Subsection (9) is added to section 627.701,
Florida Statutes, to read:
627.701 Liability of insureds; coinsurance; deductibles
(9) With respect to residential property insurance
policies, the hurricane deductible amounts set forth in this
section shall apply only once during each calendar year,
regardless of the number of hurricanes that affect the insured
property. The Florida Hurricane Catastrophe Fund shall develop a
program to reimburse insurance companies for losses that result
due to the application of this subsection.
Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
