A bill to be entitled

An act relating to discount medical plan organizations; delaying the date by which such an organization or marketer must comply with the requirements of part II of ch. 636, F.S., relating to the licensure and regulation of discount medical plan organizations; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the effective date of January 1, 2005, specified in section 31 of chapter 2004-297, Laws of Florida, a person who does business as a discount medical plan organization or who markets a discount medical plan is not subject to the requirements of part II of chapter 636, Florida Statutes, until March 31, 2005.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

SENATE SUMMARY

Delays from January 1, 2005, until March 31, 2005, the date by which a discount medical plan organization or marketer must comply with licensure and regulatory requirements.
