(1)(a) When by or pursuant to the laws of any other state or foreign country any taxes, licenses, and other fees, in the aggregate, and any fines, penalties, deposit requirements, or other material obligations, prohibitions, or restrictions are or would be imposed upon Florida insurers or upon the agents or representatives of such insurers, which are in excess of such taxes, licenses, and other fees, in the aggregate, or which are in excess of the fines, penalties, deposit requirements, or other obligations, prohibitions, or restrictions directly imposed upon similar insurers, or upon the agents or representatives of such insurers, of such other state or country under the statutes of this state, so long as such laws of such other state or country continue in force or are so applied, the same taxes, licenses, and other fees, in the aggregate, or fines, penalties, deposit requirements, or other material obligations, prohibitions, or restrictions of whatever kind shall be imposed by the Department of Revenue upon the insurers, or upon the agents or representatives of such insurers, of such other state or country doing business or seeking to do business in this state. (b) As used in this subsection, the term "portion of the remaining 20 percent" shall be calculated by multiplying the remaining 20 percent by a fraction, the numerator of which is the sum of the salaries qualifying for the credit allowed by 624.509(5) of employees whose place of employment is located in an enterprise zone created pursuant to chapter 290 and the denominator of which is the sum of the salaries qualifying for the credit allowed by 624.509(5).

Section 8. The Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability shall conduct an evaluation of the tax incentives available to rural enterprise zones and the effectiveness of rural enterprise zones in creating jobs. In particular, the evaluation must consider whether existing tax and other financial incentives available under the Enterprise Zone Act are appropriate for businesses located in rural enterprise zones and whether incentives such as the transfer of unused tax credits would enhance the effectiveness of rural enterprise zones. The evaluation shall include an estimation of the costs of new tax incentives. The evaluation shall also identify obstacles faced by rural enterprise zones and recommend possible solutions. The Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability shall conduct its evaluation and make a report containing its findings and recommendations to the Legislature by December 1, 2005.

Section 9. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
