Section 10. Subsections (3) and (4) of section 713.24, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

713.24 Transfer of liens to security.--

(3) Any party having an interest in such security or the property from which the lien was transferred may at any time, and any number of times, file a complaint in chancery in the circuit court of the county where such security is deposited, or file a motion in a pending action to enforce a lien, for an order to require additional security, reduction of security, change or substitution of sureties, payment of discharge thereof, or any other matter affecting said security. If the court finds that the amount of the deposit or bond in excess of the amount claimed in the claim of lien is insufficient to pay the lienor's attorney's fees and court

1 costs incurred in the action to enforce the lien, the court
 2 must increase the amount of the cash deposit or lien transfer
 3 bond. Nothing in this section shall be construed to vest
 4 exclusive jurisdiction in the circuit courts over transfer

 6 jurisdiction of the county courts.
