Section 1. No later than July 1, 2006, the school board of each public school district must promulgate policies that will ensure that the students in that school district are not released from the schools to persons who are not authorized to retrieve them. These policies must include a requirement that

24 the person attempting to retrieve the student present a picture 25 identification to the school principal or his or her designee before the student is released to the person. As used in this 26 27 section, the term "picture identification" means a valid state 28 driver's license, a valid state identification card, or a valid 29 United States military identification card. Copies of the policies must be provided to the Department of Education. 30 Section 2.
