As part of this pilot project, 23 the department shall submit details of the program along with a budget request for use of funds from the Solid Waste Management 24 25 Trust Fund to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, prior to the start of 26 27 the 2006 Regular Session of the Legislature. 28 Section 2.
