An act relating to commuter rail projects; amending s. 341.303, F.S.; requiring the Department of Transportation to enter into certain interlocal agreements for public transit commuter rail projects; requiring certain conditions and provisions for the agreements; providing for counties and municipalities to provide input to address the allocation of certain funding; providing for counties and municipalities to commit future year funding for all phases of commuter rail projects; providing for enforceability of commitments; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Paragraph (d) is added to subsection (3) of section 341.303, Florida Statutes, to read:
- 341.303 Funding authorization and appropriations; eligibility and participation.--
- (3) FUND PARTICIPATION; CAPITAL ASSISTANCE; INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS.--
- (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the department shall enter into interlocal agreements with affected counties and cities for public transit commuter rail projects provided the agreement:
- 1. Commits each affected city and county to the planning and, if appropriate, the completion of the project;

2. Provides specific authority and responsibility for each city and county to provide input and recommendations concerning the funding formula to address the allocation of the local government, nonfederal share of funding between the affected counties and cities for the entire cost of the project;

- 3. Provides specific authority to each city and county to commit future funding that all parties to the agreement may rely upon in the future, for all phases of the project including preliminary engineering, final design, right-of-way acquisition, and construction; and
- 4. Provides that the commitments made in the interlocal agreement are legally binding and enforceable as to each county and city.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
