16 who violates this section is guilty of a felony ~~misdemeanor~~
17 the third ~~second~~ degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082,
18 ~~or s. 775.083, or s.775.084.~~ The statute of limitations for
19 prosecution of an act committed in violation of this section
20 is 5 years from the date the act was committed.
