On page 4, line 2, delete that line

and insert: seaport security officer. In accordance with s. 311.12(4), it is the intent of the Legislature to provide seaports in this state with the ability to mitigate operational security costs without reducing security through a combination of sworn law enforcement officers and certified private security services as provided in this section. To the maximum extent feasible, the Florida Department of Law Enforcement shall apply this intent in achieving the security requirements as required in s. 311.12.
