The Committee on Domestic Security (Hill) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 5, lines 13 through 29, delete those lines

and insert: security officer.--

(1) Any facility security officer as designated under 33 C.F.R. part 105 for each seaport identified in s. 311.09, or any employee or agent holding a Class D or Class G license and certification as a seaport security officer who is designated by the facility security officer to maintain order and provide security within the seaport, who has probable cause to believe that a person is trespassing in a designated restricted-access area of a seaport under s. 810.08 or s. 810.09, may take the person into custody and detain him or her in a reasonable manner for a reasonable length of time pending the arrival of a law enforcement officer. Taking a person into custody or detention for trespassing does not render the seaport security officer criminally or civilly liable for false arrest, false imprisonment, or unlawful detention. If a

1 trespasser is taken into custody, a law enforcement officer
 2 shall be called to the scene immediately after the person is
 3 taken into custody.

4 (2) If an employee who is authorized to work at a
 5 seaport is unreasonably taken into custody and detained for
 6 trespassing in a designated restricted-access area by a
 7 seaport security officer, the seaport authority shall pay the
 8 salary of the employee during the time the employee is
 9 detained while awaiting the arrival of a law enforcement
 10 officer to take the employee into custody.
