## CHAMBER ACTION

1 The Elder & Long-Term Care Committee recommends the following: 2 3 Council/Committee Substitute 4 Remove the entire bill and insert: A bill to be entitled 5 6 An act relating to immunizations; amending s. 381.005, 7 F.S.; requiring certain assisted living facilities to 8 implement a program to offer immunizations against 9 influenza viruses to residents; requiring the Department of Health to send such facilities reminder notices each 10 year; amending s. 1003.22, F.S.; requiring each district 11 12 school board and the governing authority of each private school to provide information to parents concerning 13 14 meningococcal disease and its vaccine; requiring the Department of Health to adopt rules specifying the age or 15 grade level of students for whom such information will be 16 17 provided; requiring each district school board and the governing authority of each private school to determine 18 19 the means and method for the provision of information to 20 parents regarding meningococcal disease; providing an effective date. 21 22

Subsection (3) of section 381.005, Florida 26 Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (4) and a new subsection 27 (3) is added to said section to read: 381.005 Primary and preventive health services.--28 29 (3) Between October 1, or earlier if the vaccination is available, and February 1 of each year, subject to the 30 31 availability of an adequate supply of the necessary vaccine, 32 each assisted living facility licensed pursuant to chapter 400 33 that has 11 or more residents shall implement a program to offer 34 immunizations against influenza viruses to all residents who are 35 age 65 or older, in accordance with the recommendations of the 36 Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices of the United 37 States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and subject to the clinical judgment of the responsible practitioner. By 38 September 1 of each year, the department shall send to each 39 40 assisted living facility covered by this section a reminder notice relating to the facility's responsibilities under this 41 42 section. Section 2. Subsection (10) of section 1003.22, Florida 43 Statutes, is amended to read: 44 45 1003.22 School-entry health examinations; immunization 46 against communicable diseases; exemptions; duties of Department of Health.--47 48 (10) Each district school board and the governing authority of each private school shall: 49 50 Refuse admittance to any child otherwise entitled to (a) 51 admittance to kindergarten, or any other initial entrance into a Page 2 of 3

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(b) Temporarily exclude from attendance any student who isnot in compliance with the provisions of subsection (4).

56 (c) Provide detailed information to every student's parent concerning the causes, symptoms, and transmission of 57 meningococcal disease; the risks associated with meningococcal 58 59 disease; and the availability, effectiveness, and known 60 contraindications of any required or recommended vaccine against meningococcal disease, in accordance with the recommended ages 61 62 of students determined by the Department of Health to be 63 appropriate for the administration of such vaccine. The 64 Department of Health shall adopt rules that specify the age or 65 grade level of students for whom such information shall be 66 provided, consistent with the recommendations of the Advisory 67 Committee on Immunization Practices of the United States Centers 68 for Disease Control and Prevention concerning the appropriate 69 age for the administration of the vaccine, and shall make 70 available to school districts and the governing authorities of 71 each private school information concerning the causes, symptoms, 72 and transmission of meningococcal disease; the risks associated 73 with meningococcal disease; and the availability, effectiveness, 74 and known contraindications of any required or recommended 75 vaccine. Each district school board and the governing authority 76 of each private school shall determine the means and methods for 77 the provision of such information to students' parents. 78 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.

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
