Senator Baker moved the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 8, lines 8 and 9,

insert:

Section 4. Section 791.0125, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

791.0125 Fire prevention and control of consumer fireworks and sparklers.--To ensure uniform fire prevention and safety standards for the use of consumer fireworks and sparklers, except for federal law, the Legislature has exclusive power to regulate the sale, use, safety standards, and possession of fireworks in this state. A county, municipality, or other unit of local government may not enact any ordinance, rule, regulation, or other law after March 8, 2005, which prohibits or interferes with the safety standards established by state law or the right to purchase, sell, use, or possess consumer fireworks and sparklers in this state. This preemption shall stand repealed on July 1, 2006, if the Legislature enacts legislation to provide for the
