Florida Building Commission review of 15 16 construction practices and inspections .--17 (1) LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS AND INTENT. -- The Legislature 18 finds that, due to the rapidly increasing rate of construction which has occurred in the first few years of the 21st century, 19 the possibility exists for an increase in the prevalence of 2.0 21 construction flaws and for a decrease in the quality of building and home inspections. The intent of the Legislature 22 23 is that the review initiated under this act will produce findings that will increase the quality of construction and 2.4 optimize the effectiveness of home inspections, while 2.5 promoting the safety, accountability, and affordability of 26 27 construction in this state. 28 (2) REVIEW PROCEDURES. -- Beginning July 1, 2005, the Florida Building Commission shall conduct a review of current 29 construction practices in this state to formulate 30 recommendations concerning how to improve the quality of

1	construction in the state and how to maximize the
2	effectiveness of the building inspections and home inspections
3	associated with such construction. The commission shall
4	conduct or contract for research that supports this purpose
5	and shall conduct hearings and any other activities that the
6	commission considers essential in fulfilling this purpose.
7	(3) REPORTBy January 15, 2006, the Florida Building
8	Commission shall submit a report of its findings to the
9	Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the
10	House of Representatives. The report must include
11	recommendations for proposed legislation that the commission
12	considers appropriate and necessary.
13	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
