8 316.1936 Possession of open containers of alcoholic
9 beverages in vehicles prohibited; penalties.--

10 (9) A bottle of wine that has been resealed pursuant
11 to s. 564.09 is not an open container under the provisions of
12 this section.

13 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.

18 The committee substitute defines a full course meal as
19 consisting of a salad or vegetable, entree, a beverage, and
20 bread. It also eliminates the provision that permits
transport of the container in a locked nonpassenger area to
21 permit transport in a nonpassenger area.
