11	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
12	
13	Section 1. <u>(1) The Entertainment Industry Financial</u>
14	Incentive Trust Fund is created within, and shall be
15	administered by, the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic
16	Development. Moneys credited to the fund shall be those
17	appropriated from the General Revenue Fund or from other
18	sources to make incentive payments under section 288.1254,
19	Florida Statutes. The purpose of the trust fund is to
20	facilitate the payment of incentives under such program.
21	(2) Notwithstanding section 216.301, Florida Statutes,
22	and under section 216.351, Florida Statutes, any balance in
23	the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain in
24	the trust fund at the end of the fiscal year and shall be
25	available for carrying out the purposes of the trust fund.
26	(3) In accordance with Section 19(f)(2), Article III
27	of the State Constitution, the trust fund must, unless
28	terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2009. Before its
29	scheduled termination, the trust fund must be reviewed as
30	provided in section 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida Statutes.
