Any person who sells or 18 rents adult video games must require that a person buying or renting an adult video game present proof of age. 19 20 (2) As used in this section, the term "adult video 21 game" means any video recording of a game which contains 22 representations or images of excessive violence, nudity or 23 sexual conduct that is harmful to persons younger than 18 years of age, or criminal activity. 2.4 (3) Any person who knowingly sells or rents an adult 25 video game to a person younger than 18 years of age commits a 26 27 felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in section 2.8 775.082, section 775.083, or section 775.084, Florida 29 Statutes. 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2005. 31

********** SENATE SUMMARY Provides that it is a third-degree felony for a person to sell or rent an adult video game to a person younger than 18 years of age. Requires that a person buying or renting an adult video game present proof of age. Defines the term "adult video game" to mean a video game that depicts excessive violence, nudity or sexual conduct that is harmful to persons younger than 18 years of age, or criminal activity.
