The Committee on Judiciary (Campbell) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 23, between lines 14 and 15,

insert:

Section 2. An annual fee of \$150 per slot machine is imposed upon each slot machine approved for use at any eligible facility as defined in section 551.102, Florida Statutes, which is within 2 miles of any neighboring municipality. A "neighboring municipality" is a municipality that does not have an eligible facility but has two facilities located within 2 miles of its municipal borders and is the municipality with the largest population in the county. Revenue from the fees imposed by this section must be used by the neighboring municipality to fund the adverse public health, safety, and welfare and public works and traffic impacts that will be caused by the implementation of Section 23, Article X of the State Constitution and that will occur as a direct result of slot machine operation. The annual fee must

1 be remitted to the Department of Business and Professional
2 Regulation to be deposited into the Slot Machine
3 Administrative Trust Fund and distributed by the department to
4 any neighboring municipality. The fee must be remitted by
5 February 1 of each year based on the number of slot machines
6 approved as of January 1.
