Senate Amendment

On page 9, lines 1-7, delete those lines

and insert:

(b) Continue to be in compliance with chapter 550, where applicable, and maintain the pari-mutuel permit and license in good standing pursuant to the provisions of chapter 550. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law and in order to expedite the operation of slot machines at eligible facilities, any eligible facility shall be entitled within 60 days of the effective date of this act to amend its 2005-2006 license issued by the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering and shall be granted the requested changes in its authorized performances pursuant to such amendment. The Division of Pari-mutuel Wagering shall issue a new license to the eligible facility to effectuate an amendment.

(c) Conduct no fewer than the greater number of live races or games that were conducted at that pari-mutuel
