The Committee on Judiciary (Webster) recommended the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 2, line 14, through page 3, line 7, delete those lines

and insert: pari-mutuel permitholder was authorized to conduct pari-mutuel wagering activities pursuant to such permitholder's valid pari-mutuel permit or as otherwise authorized by law provided a majority of voters in a countywide referendum have approved the possession of slot machines at such facility in the respective county. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, it is not a crime for a person to participate in slot machine gaming at a facility licensed to possess and conduct slot machine gaming or to participate in slot machine gaming described in this chapter.

551.102 Definitions.--As used in this chapter, the term:

(1) "Central control computer" means a central site
