staff of a statutory teaching hospital in this state as defined in s. 408.07. At least one of the physicians must be a graduate of a foreign medical school. The remaining five three members must be residents of the state who have lived in the state for at least 5 years immediately preceding their appointments, have never been licensed as a health care practitioner under chapter 456 or the applicable practice act, and do not have a substantial personal, business, professional, or pecuniary connection with a licensed health care practitioner or with a medical education or health care facility, except as patients or potential patients are not, and never have been, licensed health care practitioners. One member must be a health care risk manager licensed under s. 395.10974. At least one member of the board must be 60 years of age or older. The requirements of this subsection shall be a continuing condition of membership on the board. Any member who ceases to meet the requirements of this subsection shall be removed from the board, and a new qualified member shall be appointed to fill the vacancy for the remainder of that member's term.

Statutes, as amended by this act, shall apply to appointments made on or after the effective date of this act and shall not be construed to end the term of any member of the Board of Medicine holding that appointment on the effective date of this act.
