Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 5, between lines 6 and 7,

insert:

Section 5. Section 166.0498, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

166.0498 Closing of a road by a municipality.--A municipality may not permanently close a road that crosses into or through an adjoining municipality until the following conditions have been met:

(1) The municipality closing the road must adopt an ordinance and provide notice to the adjoining municipality of the public hearing for the adoption of the ordinance;

(2) The closure may not leave an area within the adjoining municipality with only one means of egress or ingress into the area;

(3) The closure must be reviewed by each municipality's emergency services providers, including, but not limited to, police and fire rescue, who must make a

1 determination that the road closure will not adversely impact
 2 the delivery of such emergency services by an entity or
 3 adversely impact local or regional emergency preparedness,
 4 including, but not limited to, eliminating potential
 5 evacuation routes; and

6 (4) The municipality that is closing the road must
 7 provide signage, lighting, other necessary and appropriate
 8 safety signals for traffic, and paved roundabouts or other
 9 turn-around capability for all emergency vehicles on both
 10 sides of the barrier.
