A bill to be entitled

An act relating to elections; creating s.
98.485, F.S.; requiring each county supervisor
of elections to submit to the district school
board a calendar of election dates; requiring
scheduled days to coincide with election dates
and schools to be made available as polling
places; requiring timely notification;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 98.485, Florida Statutes, is
created to read:

98.485 Election dates.--The supervisor of elections in
each county shall submit to the respective district school
board a calendar of election dates. Based on the submission of
such information, each district school board shall schedule
days to coincide with primary and general election dates and
make its schools available as polling places. The supervisor
of elections shall coordinate with the district school board
to ensure that the district school board is notified in a
timely manner for purposes of planning for the school year.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
