32 Being more particularly described as follows:

34 Beginning at the Northwest corner of said Section 24,  
35 (all bearings are based on the line between Sections  
36 13 and 24 being N88°08'55"W). Thence following the  
37 westerly limit of said Section 24 S02°15'48"W a  
38 distance of 1621.00 feet more or less to the  
39 intersection of the north limit of the Plat for  
40 Whitehorse Estates as recorded in Plat Book 78, Pages  
41 92 through 95. Thence following the northerly limit of  
42 said plat S88°09'55"E a distance of 1333.05 feet to a  
43 point. Thence following said northerly limit  
44 N89°08'55"E a distance more or less of 1334.10 feet to  
45 a point. Thence following the northerly line of said  
46 plat S85°05'57"E a distance of 25.05 feet to a point.  
47 Thence following the northerly limit of said plat  
48 N88°52'02"E a distance of 2366.99 feet more or less to  
49 the intersection for the widening of State Road 7  
50 right of way, per Section 93210-2519, Florida  
51 Department of Transportation. Thence along the said  
52 westerly right of way N01°53'40"E a distance of  
53 2791.44 feet more or less to a point of intersection  
54 with the southerly limit of a plat for Wellington  
55 Green, a MUPD/PUD as recorded in Plat Book 87, Pages  
56 81 through 90. Thence along the southerly limit of the

57 said plat N88°05'25"W a distance of 5044.51 feet more  
58 or less to a point in the westerly limit of said  
59 Section 13. Thence following the said westerly limit  
60 S01°52'58"W a distance of 1360.8 feet to the point of  
61 beginning. Said lands contain 337.7 acres more or  
62 less, subject to existing Easements, Right-of-ways,  
63 Restrictions and Reservations of Record.

65 (3) If a majority of the voters residing within Area A and  
66 a majority of the voters residing within the territorial limits  
67 of the district voting in the referendum as provided in  
68 subsection (1) determine that the lands described in subsection  
69 (2) should be included within the territorial limits of the  
70 district, said lands shall be included within the district  
71 boundaries 10 days following the date of the referendum.

72 Section 2. The lands added to the Acme Improvement  
73 District in section 1 of this act are removed and deleted from  
74 within the boundary lines of the Lake Worth Drainage District, a  
75 corporation under the drainage laws of the state, existing in  
76 Palm Beach County, as codified under chapter 98-525, Laws of  
77 Florida.

78 Section 3. Subsections (2) and (3) of section 1 and  
79 section 2 of this act shall take effect only upon their approval  
80 by a majority vote of those qualified electors authorized under  
81 section 1 and voting in a referendum election to be called by  
82 the Acme Improvement District to be held on or before December  
83 30, 2006, in accordance with the provisions of law relating to  
84 elections currently in force, except that subsection (1) of
