10	Section 1. Extension of district boundaries; Area A
11	(1) The Acme Improvement District shall call and the
12	Supervisor of Elections of Palm Beach County shall conduct a
13	referendum on or before December 30, 2006, in accordance with
14	provisions of law relating to elections currently in force. The
15	purpose of said referendum shall be to determine whether the
16	lands within Area A as described in subsection (2) will be
17	included within the territorial limits of the district and
18	subject to assessment. Only those registered voters residing
19	within Area A and only those registered voters residing within
20	the existing territorial limits of the district may vote in said
21	referendum.
22	(2) The legal description of Area A is as follows:

24	A parcel of land lying in Sections 13 and 24, Township
25	44 S, Range 41 E, and being parts of Lots 1 and 8 and

78	Section 3. Subsections (2) and (3) of section 1 and

81	section 1 and voting in a referendum election to be called by
82	the Acme Improvement District to be held on or before December
83	30, 2006, in accordance with the provisions of law relating to
