Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 2, between lines 13 and 14,

insert:

(4) Each district school board shall, no later than August 1, 2006, appoint from current staff a performing and fine arts coordinator to implement any policy for performing and fine arts developed and implemented by the district school board.

Section 2. Subsection (4) is added to section 1003.455, Florida Statutes, to read:

1003.455 Physical education; assessment.--

(4) Each district school board shall, no later than August 1, 2005, appoint from current staff a physical education coordinator to implement any physical education program developed by the district school board resulting from the physical education assessment completed according to this section.
