Senate Amendment

On page 8, line 21 through page 9, line 5 delete those lines

and insert:

Section 5. The Department of Environmental Protection, in coordination with the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, shall undertake a study evaluating the current use of state parks for purposes of recreational boating and identify opportunities for increasing recreational boating access within the state park system and determine impacts on existing recreational uses and wildlife needs. The study must include recommendations regarding the most appropriate locations for expanding existing recreational boating access and must identify state parks where new recreational boating access may be located. Recommendations are to include impacts on existing recreational uses and wildlife needs. The report must contain estimates of the costs necessary to expand and

2 specific state parks. The department shall submit a report
3 summarizing its findings and recommendations to the Governor,
