- (4) The Auditor General may audit a qualified job training organization to verify that the distributions to the organization under this section have been expended by the organization as required by this section. If the Auditor General determines that the distributions have not been expended as required by this section, the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development may pursue recovery of such proceeds pursuant to the laws and rules governing the assessment of taxes.
- (5) Failure to use the proceeds as provided in this section constitutes grounds for revoking certification.

Section 2. The sum of \$3 million is appropriated each year for 10 years from nonrecurring general revenue to the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development for the purpose specified in s. 288.1171(3), Florida Statutes. For the 2005-2006 fiscal year, these funds are appropriated from nonrecurring general revenue. For fiscal years 2006-2007 through 2015-2016, the funds appropriated shall be appropriated from nonrecurring general revenue or as specifically provided in the General Appropriations Act. Such appropriated funds shall be distributed by the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development to organizations meeting the requirements of s. 288.1171(1), Florida Statutes, solely to encourage and provide economic development through capital construction, improvements, or purchases of equipment that will result in expanded employment opportunities.
