An act relating to Broward County; amending chapter 94-429, Laws of Florida, as amended; authorizing expenditures for the purposes enumerated therein, including meals, hospitality, and entertainment of persons in the interest of promoting and engendering goodwill toward its seaport, Port Everglades; providing severability; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 5 of chapter 94-429, Laws of Florida, as amended by chapter 99-475, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:
- Section 5. Powers and duties. -- The county shall have full power and authority:
- To create and promote commerce and industry within the county; promote the activities of its seaport; make known the advantages, facilities, resources, and attributes of its seaport; and, in furtherance thereof, authorize expenditures for the purposes of this subsection, including meals, hospitality, and entertainment of persons in the interest of promoting and engendering goodwill toward its port jurisdictional area, as defined in subsection (3) of section 2 of chapter 94-429, Laws of Florida, as amended by chapter 99-475, Laws of Florida, which area shall be known as Port Everglades.
- Severability. -- It is declared to be the Section 2. legislative intent that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or provision or part thereof of this act is held
