Section 3. Subsection (47) of section 39.01, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

39.01 Definitions.--When used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:

(47) "Other person responsible for a child's welfare" includes the child's legal guardian, legal custodian, or foster parent; an employee of a private school, public or private child day care center, residential home, institution, facility, or agency; a law enforcement officer or employee of a municipal or county detention facility or of the Department of Corrections while acting in an official capacity, public school volunteer, religious organization volunteer, health care provider, or any other person legally responsible for the child's welfare in a residential setting; and also includes an adult sitter or relative entrusted with a child's care. ~~For~~
