Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 1008.36, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

20 21 (3) All public schools, including charter schools, that receive a school grade pursuant to s. 1008.34 are eligible to participate in the program. For the purpose of this section, a

students that does not receive a school grade under s. 1008.34
shall be assigned the school performance grade of the feeder
pattern school designated by the Department of Education and
verified by the school district and shall be eligible to
participate in the program based on that feeder. A feeder school
pattern is defined as a pattern where at least 60 percent of the
students in the school receiving the school grade came from the
same feeder school. In addition, the feeder pattern school shall
be subject to the Opportunity Scholarship Program as defined in
s. 1002.38.

Notwithstanding statutory provisions to the contrary, incentive awards are not subject to collective bargaining.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
