This legislation re-creates the State Game Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2008. The State Game Trust Fund, FLAIR #77-2-672, is administered by the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission. This fund was last re-created effective by Chapter 2001-31, Laws of Florida.

The State Game Trust Fund is used as the commission deems appropriate in carrying out the operations of the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission. Section 372.09, F.S., provides sources of revenue from the administration of the laws and regulations pertaining to birds, game, fur-bearing animals, freshwater fish, reptiles, and amphibians, together with any other funds specifically provided for such purposes.

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
