A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to trust funds; creating s.  
20.1971, F.S.; creating the Federal Grants  
Trust Fund within the Agency for Persons with  
Disabilities; providing sources of funds and  
purposes; providing for annual carryforward of  
funds; providing for future review and  
termination or re-creation of the trust fund;  
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 20.1971, Florida Statutes, is  
created to read:

20.1971 Agency for Persons with Disabilities; trust  
funds.--The following trust funds are created and shall be  
administered by the Agency for Persons with Disabilities:

(5) The Federal Grants Trust Fund.

(a) Funds to be credited to the trust fund shall  
consist of receipts from federal grants. Funds shall be used  
for the purpose of providing health care services to agency  
clients and for other such purposes as may be appropriate and  
shall be expended only pursuant to legislative appropriation  
or an approved amendment to the agency's operating budget  
pursuant to the provisions of chapter 216.

(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and  
pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the  
end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the  
end of the year and shall be available for carrying out the  
purposes of the trust fund.
