A bill to be entitled

An act relating to education; authorizing individual district school boards by resolution to allow an inspirational message at specified secondary school-related events; providing legislative intent; providing severability; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Any district school board is authorized to adopt a resolution allowing the use of an inspirational message at a secondary school commencement exercise or a secondary school-related noncompulsory student assembly. The resolution must provide:

(1) That the use of an inspirational message shall be at the discretion of the students.

(2) That an inspirational message, if used, shall be given by a student volunteer.

(3) That an inspirational message shall be nonsectarian and nonproselytizing in nature.

(4) That school personnel shall not participate in or otherwise influence the exercise of the discretion of the students in the determination of whether to use an inspirational message.

Section 2. The purpose of this act is to provide for the solemnization and memorialization of secondary school events and ceremonies, and this act is not intended to advance or endorse any religion or religious belief.

Section 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held

1 invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or  
2 applications of the act that can be given effect without the  
3 invalid provision or application, and to this end the  
4 provisions of this act are declared severable.

5 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
