The Legislature declares that the Kissimmee River 34 (3) 35 Restoration Project, the Ten Mile Creek Project, the Water 36 Preserve Areas, the Southern Corkscrew Regional Ecosystem 37 Watershed Project, the Pal-Mar Project, and the C-111 Project, 38 the C-111 Spreader Canal Project, and the Biscayne Bay Coastal Wetlands-Phase 1 Project - C-1 Cutler Wetlands Component are in 39 40 the public interest, for a public purpose, and necessary for the 41 public health and welfare. The governing board of the district 42 is empowered and authorized to acquire fee title or easement by 43 eminent domain for the limited purposes of implementing the 44 Kissimmee River Restoration Project, the Ten Mile Creek Project, 45 the Water Preserve Areas, the Southern Corkscrew Regional 46 Ecosystem Watershed Project, the Pal-Mar Project, and the C-111 47 Project, the C-111 Spreader Canal Project, and the Biscayne Bay 48 Coastal Wetlands-Phase 1 Project - C-1 Cutler Wetlands 49 Component. Any acquisition of real property, including by eminent domain, for those objectives constitutes a public 50 purpose for which it is in the public interest to expend public 51 52 funds. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, 53 such properties shall not be removed from the district's plan of 54 acquisition, and the use of state funds for these properties is 55 authorized. In the absence of willing sellers, any land 56 necessary for implementing the projects in this subsection shall
